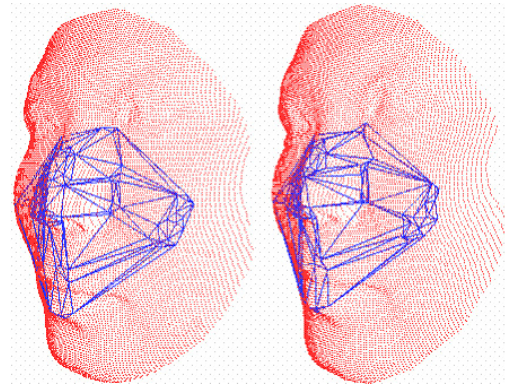

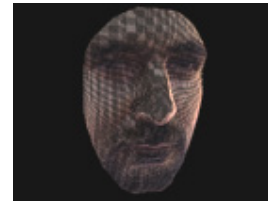

## **STI-Global Enters Advanced 3D Security Project**

STI-Global has joined with Jazzmatrix Corporation to form a new company called **3Di-Matrix** to secure an exclusive licence for world-leading 3D Hybrid Face Recognition Technology developed by the University of Western Australia. Jazzmatrix is an Australian company with strong links in South Africa, and has been a leader and supplier for the UN providing fraud prevention systems in South Africa.



The 3D Hybrid Face Recognition System (3Di-Matrix) uses a unique methodology to determine texture and 3D shape of the face to identify people. It is very accurate even in the presence of pose, expression and illumination variations. It can also recognise a face which is not fully visible.



Unique Benefits:

- Recognises previously registered peoples' faces with high accuracy
- Utilises robust algorithms to make recognitions
- Accurate even if the face is masked, they are wearing sun glasses or a beard
- It cannot be fooled by makeup
- Two step process - unlike faces are rejected before a final stage of matching

Applications of the technology include security, fraud prevention for the ATO, Social Security Departments, surveillance, access control, military applications, passport control, criminal identification and forensics. 3Di-Matrix already has a number of large government agencies and private corporations both in Australia, South Africa and the United States interested in market segment licenses.

This is an exciting new value-adding technology for the Company and builds on the security and market access channels of both STI-Global and Jazzmatrix.
